

FRENCH FRIED SKUNK

2 Skunks, Skinned and Cleaned 1 Tbl. Salt 2 C. Bear Fat or Lard 3 C. Milk or Cream 1/2 tsp. Salt

Water to Cover 2 Egg Yolks, Beaten 1-1/2 C. Flour 2 Tbl. Baking Powder

Clean and wash the skunks, making sure that the scent glands are removed. Cut up into small serving pieces. Put a soup kettle on the stove and add the meat. Cover with cold water and bring to a boil over high heat. Lower the heat and boil until the meat is tender, about 40 minutes. Remove all the scum that rises to the surface. Make a batter by mixing together the egg yolks, milk, flour, salt and baking powder. Mix real good until the batter is about like cake batter. Heat the bear fat or lard in a deep fryer to about 360 degrees. Dip the pieces of skunk in the batter and then fry them in the deep fryer until golden brown. Drain well

and serve.


