

VEGAN ALFREDO WITH VEGGIÉS 1/4 cup flour


1/3 cup unsalted raw cashews 2 cups sliced button mushrooms 2 Tbsp. olive oil 8 oz. whole-grain spaghetti

1/2 cup frozen peas and carrots 2 cups fresh spinach or arugula 1-1/4 cups water

Put cashews in a small bowl; add enough boiling water to cover. Let stand, covered, 20 minutes. Drain, rinse, and drain again. Cook mushrooms in 1 Tbsp. oil in a large skillet over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until browned, about 5 minutes. Meanwhile, cook spaghetti in a large pot of boiling water according to package directions, adding peas and carrots in last minute of cooking; drain. Return pasta mixture to pot. Add mushrooms and spinach; cook over low heat, stirring frequently, until spinach is wilted. Whisk together 1-1/4 cups water and the flour in a small saucepan until smooth. Simmer over medium heat, stirring frequently, until golden and pourable, about 3 minutes. Transfer flour mixture to a blender; add soaked cashews, lemon juice, garlic, salt, pepper, and remaining 1 Tbsp. oil. Blend until smooth. Serve sauce over pasta mixture, sprinkled with additional pepper and lemon juice.





Perhaps in part due to the popular 1991 film "Fried Green Tomatoes," many people are familiar with the Southern United States side dish of the same name. But as proven by the following recipe for "Grilled Green Tomato 'Sandwiches' with Herbed Cream Cheese" from Karen Adler and Judith Fertig's The Gardener & The Grill" (Running Press), green tomatoes can be even more delicious when grilled than they are when fried.

GRILLED GREEN TOMATO "SANDWICHES" WITH HERBED CREAM CHEESE Serves 6 HERBED CREAM CHEESE 1 8-ounce package cream cheese at room temperature 1 garlic clove minced 2 tablespoons chopped fresh basil

1 tablespoon snipped fresh chives

TOMATOES

4 large green tomatoes (about 11/2 pounds), sliced 3/4-inch thick (to make 12 slices) Olive oil, for brushing 2 teaspoons Seasoning Salt (see below) or kosher salt & Ground black pepper



Prepare a medium-hot fire in your grill. Place a well-oiled perforated grill rack over direct heat. In a bowl, blend the cream cheese, garlic, basil, and chives together until smooth. Set aside. Brush the tomato slices with olive oil on both sides and season with seasoning salt and pepper. Place the slices on a baking sheet and bring out to the grill with the bowl of Herbed Cream Cheese and a knife for spread-

ing. Grill all of the tomatoes on one side for about 3 minutes with the lid open, then flip and grill on the other side for 3 minutes more, or until the tomatoes have good grill marks.

Remove the tomato slices from the grill and allow to cool slightly on the baking sheet. Spread Herbed Cream Cheese on half of the slices, top with a second slice and set the sandwiches on a platter. Serve the sandwiches hot, with oozing cream cheese fillina.

Variation: Grill all of the tomato slices as above and top each grilled tomato with a dollop of the cream cheese and serve openfaced.

SEASONING SALT Makes 11/4 cups

- 1 cup sea salt
- 2 tablespoons paprika
- 1 teaspoon parsley flakes 1 teaspoon dried chives
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon dried marjoram leaves
- 1/2 teaspoon celery seed 1/2 teaspoon curry powder 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder 1/4 teaspoon red pepper

Combine all of the ingredients in a glass jar and cover with a tightfitting lid. Shake to blend. This keeps for several months in the pantry.



Tips For Planting Fall Vegetables

Tending to backyard vegetable gardens can fill many hours of enjoyable downtime in the great outdoors. What's more, the bounty produced by such gar-dens provides healthy, fresh foods to gardeners and their loved ones.

Although spring and summer are widely seen as the peak of gardening season, the mild temperatures of autumn can be a prime time for planting vegetables as well. Certain lateseason treats like carrots, kale, spinach, and turnips can thrive in fall gardens. Many different foods are quick crops that can go from seed to table in about six weeks. When sown in early fall, these vegetables will be ready to put on the table for mid-October feasts. Beets, green onions, broccoli, and cabbages can be planted in late summer for fall harvest. Gardeners who live in hardiness zones eight through 10 (the southern portion of the United States) can plant fall vegetables as late as December. Many of these plants can tolerate light frost, which may even help sweeten the vegetables. A handful of unique factors

need to be taken into consideration when planning fall vegetable gardens.

· The summertime location of the garden may still be ade-quate, but be sure to choose a location that gets eight full hours of sunlight per day.

• If using an existing garden site, clear out any detritus from summer plants and any weeds that have sprouted. If you are planting a new garden, remove any turf before tilling the soil.

Amend the soil with sand, compost, manure fertilizer, and any other nutrients needed depending on the types of vegetables you intend to grow.

· While fall vegetables can be grown successfully from seeds, it may be more time-friendly to work from larger transplants, advises the Texas A&M Agrilife Extension.

· Some plants may need a little protection as they grow if temperatures begin to dip. Cover with a blanket, cardboard box or plastic tunnel to insulate.

Remember to water according to the vegetables planted and to keep an eye on readiness for vegetables. Turnips, beets, rutabagas, and carrots can be dug out when the roots are plump and crisp.

Vegetable gardens need not cease when the last days of summer vanish. Fall produce is delicious and can be easily planted and harvested even after the first frost.

7 Uses For Fallen Leaves

By the time autumn hits full swing, many trees will have shed their leaves for the season, and the last vestiges of red, yellow and orange magic have faded to brown. Raking, blowing and collecting leaves becomes the primary chores of lawn and yard maintenance, and presents most homeowners with large piles of gathered leaves to tend to. It is impossible to count just how many leaves fall to the ground each year, or just how many

pounds of leaves get collected curbside, but the numbers are substantial. Cleaning up leaves is considerable work, but not all of those leaves need to be carted away. In fact, there are several different uses of leaves that can be beneficial.

1. Spread leaves as a protective mulch to cover tender perennials or root crops/bulbs in the ground. The leaves will form a natural insulating cover that keeps the soil and the plants within a bit warmer over winter. 2. Create a pile of leaves that will break down and form a crumbly, compost-like material called leaf mold. Even though leaf mold may sound like a blight, it's actually a good amendment to garden improving its structure and ability to hold water. Leaf mold also attracts beneficial organisms that are vital in healthy soil.

3. Brown leaves can be added to green materials in compost piles to improve the health of the compost being formed. According to the healthy living resource Care2, the ideal ratio is 75 percent brown to 25 percent green materials in compost. Turn compost piles regularly to aerate them.

4. Store dried, mulched leaves in a dry spot so they can be used in the spring as a weed barrier for spring plantings. They will keep weeds at bay and help retain soil moisture to ensure small sprouts have the resources to grow.

5. Use shredded leaves as a lawn supplement. Pass a lawn mower over leaves left on the lawn to break them down into pieces too small to rake. This will help keep the lawn healthy throughout the winter without blocking out needed sunlight.

6. Bag dried leaves and pack them tightly together in cold






